6. **REPORTS AND CORRESPONDENCE**

- A. Fire Chief's Report

1. Number of Calls in April: 10 EMS calls; 1 MVA call; 2 fire. May calls to date: 8 EMS. On June 1 county wide fire ban will go into effect.
2. Grants: Paperwork for the AZ State Forestry Fuels Reduction was filed on Friday, 05-15-2020. The total grant amount is \$187K and PVFD will start using the funds in the Fall. First stage will involve removing brush on both sides of Model Creek Road. Arizona Community Foundation Grant is still open. \$3200 for tablets and IAR program - should be resolved soon. A new safer grant co-op with Southern Yavapai will be applied for soon. It is a 4 year grant for 590K which includes the cadet program, PPEs for new firefighters, some stipend reimbursement, and target solutions training.
3. Personnel/Training: Currently have 20 volunteer personnel including 3 admin, 5 seasonal reserves, and 9 EMTs.
4. EMTs: 9
5. IRWIN Status: 7 fire fighters are on IRWIN.
6. Apparatus/Equipment: All equipment is operational and EMS personnel have sufficient Personal Protective Equipment (PPE). When the funds from the AZ State Forestry Fuels Reduction Grant are released PVFD will get a chipper and a ¾ ton pickup.

7. Water Resources along Hwy 89: The water resources have been planned; construction is delayed awaiting tax resources.
 8. ISO Status: Will be done partly on the internet and partly on site - hopefully in June.
 9. Scott Mayer presented an update of the Weaver Mountain Health Initiative.
- B. Financial Report: Budget Subcommittee met and reviewed the 2020-2021 budget; the budget was approved for submittal to the fire board during the May 13, 2020 subcommittee meeting.

The new VFIS policy was presented to the board. This policy was as budgeted and was signed by the chairman.
